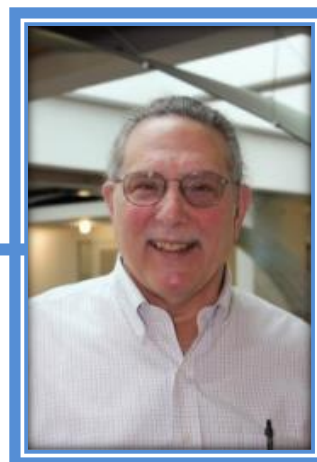

Executive Council Resolution
Recognizing

Dave Morrison

Whereas, Dave Morrison served as the Salt Lake City's USPTO librarian representative from 1987 until his retirement in 2017 at the University of Utah's J. Willard Marriott Library. He served as representative first for the Patent Depository Library (PDL), then Patent & Trademark Depository Library (PTDL), and finally the Patent and Trademark Resource Center (PTRC), in addition to duties as a government documents librarian;

Whereas, Dave Morrison was selected as thirteenth Patent Fellowship Librarian for the PTDL Program Office from 1996 to 1998. He worked at the former USPTO location in Crystal City, VA. Dave conducted historical research which was part of the 25th Anniversary celebrating cooperation between libraries and USPTO. He acted in the USPTO's *Conducting a Patent Search at a PTDL* VHS movie. Dave Morrison revised the second edition of the *Directory of Patent and Trademark Depository Libraries*;

Whereas, Dave Morrison led the Association as President in 1999-2000 and Past-President in 2001-2002. He also served as Treasurer and Chair of several committees including Archives, Finance Committee, Legislature and Government Relations Committee, and Pin Committee. Additionally, he served as a member on other Association committees, including Bylaws and Database. Finally, he was a member of the Association's informal "Old Time" band that performed at the PTRC Program's Annual Seminars and other celebrations;

Whereas, Dave Morrison taught hundreds of students, faculty, residents, and small businesses in Utah and surrounding states about patents and trademarks. A few key University of Utah groups included the technology transfer office, Center for Medical Innovation's Bench-to-Bedside annual medical device competitors, students from business, engineering, and law courses, faculty from the Entrepreneurial Faculty Scholars, Innovation Scholars, and Vice-President for Research's workshops (Research Administration Training Series or RATS). Dave also supported the Intermountain Society of Inventors and Designers;

Be it resolved that the Patent and Trademark Resource Center Association recognizes and honors Dave Morrison for his leadership and commitment to making patent and trademark information available to the

public, and for the many contributions that he has made to the Patent and Trademark Resource Center Program, to the Association, and to the United States Patent and Trademark Office.
